Customers Asking **BIG JOHN** about the 90E

We previously introduced the **BIG JOHN** 90E and wanted to share some of the questions we received and offer BIG JOHN 90E user feedback.

What is the difference between the 90D & 90E?

The 90E has shorter blade towers than the 90D which does less damage to limbs when backing up to a tree. The 90E turtle is newly designed with gate cylinders on the outside. The digger head is also 8 inches further up the lift track to help with the weight on the back axle. The overall height on the 90E is lower in transport height because of the new blade design.

Is the 90E replacing the 90D?

No. The 90D is a great unit and will be a perfect machine for most applications. The 90E with the features mentioned above will find a home with a certain segment of the tree moving population. Please contact Stephen or Will to see if 90E fits your tree moving applications. 1-800-643-8039
